Chapter 3

Contents: The common guilt of both Jew and Gentile. Justification by faith, not by the law.

Characters: *GOD, JESUS.*

Conclusion: The sum of all sin is coming short of the glory of *GOD* for which we were created—therefore all the world stands guilty before *GOD*, and unable by any works to gain acceptance with *GOD*. Justification before *GOD* is resolved thereby purely into the free gift of grace by *GOD* through *JESUS CHRIST* to all who will receive it.

Strong Verses: 4, 10-12, 20-26.

Striking Facts: 22. The gospel does not exclude anyone who is refusing to appropriate the finished work of *JESUS CHRIST*. The best brand of self-righteousness will not stand before *GOD*. We must therefore wear the righteousness which *GOD* has ordained and which is brought in by *HIS SON*. All men are equally welcome to *GOD* through *JESUS CHRIST*. *HE* has but one plan of salvation.
