Contents: Peter opens the gospel door to the Gentiles. Cornelius sends for Peter and Peter goes to Caesarea. The vision of “the clean” and the “unclean”. Peter’s sermon to the Gentiles in Cornelius’ house. **HOLY SPIRIT** comes upon Gentile believers.

Characters: **GOD, JESUS, HOLY SPIRIT**, Cornelius, angel, Peter, Simon, 3 messengers, John.

Conclusion: In **JESUS CHRIST**, there is no difference in those who are circumcised or those who are uncircumcised because **HIS** finished work, opens the door of the gospel to all who believe.
