## Genesis Chapter 12

**Contents:** Call of Abram. His worship and testing. The lack of faith and subsequent error in Egypt.

Characters: Abram, Sarai, Lot, Pharaoh.

**Conclusion:** The path into which *GOD* calls the believer may often be trying to the flesh, but this does not necessarily indicate that he is out of *GOD*'s will.

**Key Word:** Sojourners, <u>Gen\_12:10</u>.

**Strong Verses:** <u>Gen\_12:3</u>, <u>Gen\_12:8</u>.

**Striking Facts:** *GOD*'s instructions are necessary to under His presence and help. It is better to suffer in Canaan *[difficult place]* in *GOD*'s path than live disobediently in luxury in Egypt *[easy place]* following the devil's path. The altar marks Abraham as a worshipper. The tent marks him as a pilgrim. These are distinguishing marks of the followers of Christ.
