Characters: Abram, Lot.

Key Word: Separation, 9.

Strong Verses: 4, 17, 18.

Striking Facts: Lot is an example of a professing "follower of **CHRIST**" who tries to live in both worlds, 12. The believer who puts **GOD** and **CHRIST** first will never be bereftⁱ which is best for them.
