Characters: Abram, Lot.

Conclusion: Material blessings are often accompanied by moral blight. Wealth without faith is not an equal to faith alone.

Key Word: Separation, 9.

Strong Verses: 4, 17, 18.

Striking Facts: Lot is an example of a professing "follower of *CHRIST*" who tries to live in both worlds, 12. The believer who puts *GOD* and *CHRIST* first will never be bereft which is best for them.
