Gen 2:23 And Adam^{H121} said,^{H559} This^{H2063} *is* now^{H6471} bone^{H6106} of my bones,^{H4480} H6106 and flesh^{H1320} of my flesh:^{H4480} H1320 she^{H2063} shall be called^{H7121} Woman,^{H802} because^{H3588} she^{H2063} was taken^{H3947} out of Man.^{H4480} H376

Translation:

Mankind called this, stroke **this** [*she added*] the eyes bone, out of bone, flesh out of flesh, this proclaim woman because **this** [*she added*] take part of man.

Helper H5828 ay'-zer

From H5826; aid: - help.

H5826

aw-zar' A primitive root; to *surround*, that is, *protect* or *aid:* - help, succour.

Complement

H5048

neh'-ghed

From H5046; a *front*, that is, part opposite; specifically a *counterpart*, or mate; usually (adverbially, especially with preposition) *over against* or *before:* - about, (over) against, X aloof, X far (off), X from, over, presence, X other side, sight, X to view.

H5046 *naw-gad'*

A primitive root; properly to *front*, that is, **stand boldly out opposite**; by implication (causatively), to *manifest*; figuratively to *announce* (always by word of mouth to one present); specifically to *expose*, *predict*, *explain*, *praise:* - bewray, X certainly, certify, declare (-ing), denounce, expound, X fully, messenger, plainly, profess, rehearse, report, shew (forth), speak, X surely, tell, utter.
