

Romans **Chapter 10**

Contents: Israel's failure is explained by unbelief. The true plan of salvation.

Characters: **GOD**, **CHRIST**, Moses, Isaiah, Paul.

Conclusion: Neither sincerity or self-righteousness are sufficient to provide spiritual safety. The purpose of The Law was to lead people to **CHRIST**, who is the end of it, and the only ground for salvation is to have a humble faith in **CHRIST**'s satisfaction of The Law, and so be "justified through the redemption that is in **CHRIST JESUS**."

Key Word: Salvation, 1.

Strong Verses: 3, 4, 9-13, 17.

Striking Facts: 4. The Law is not destroyed by the Gospel, but full satisfaction The Law is made by **JESUS CHRIST** (since no one else could). Our continuous breach of The Law, would never be attained without the justification provided by the finished work of **JESUS CHRIST**.
