## Exodus Chapter 24 Student

**Contents:** The order of worship is prescribed, in anticipation of the building of the tabernacle.

Characters: GOD, Moses, Aaron, Nadab, Abihu, 70 elders, Joshua, Hur.

**Conclusion:** The unapproachable glory of **GOD** warns a sinner to keep a distance, but the altar shows how to feast and worship in **GOD**'s presence.

Key Word: Worship, 1.

**Strong Verses:** 8, 17.

**Striking Facts:** We never hear "draw near" (Hebrews 10:22) from the shadows of THE LAW. The work of **CHRIST**'s made it possible for a sinner to "draw near". THE LAW always says "worship afar off", because access is based on our works instead of the grace of **CHRIST**.
