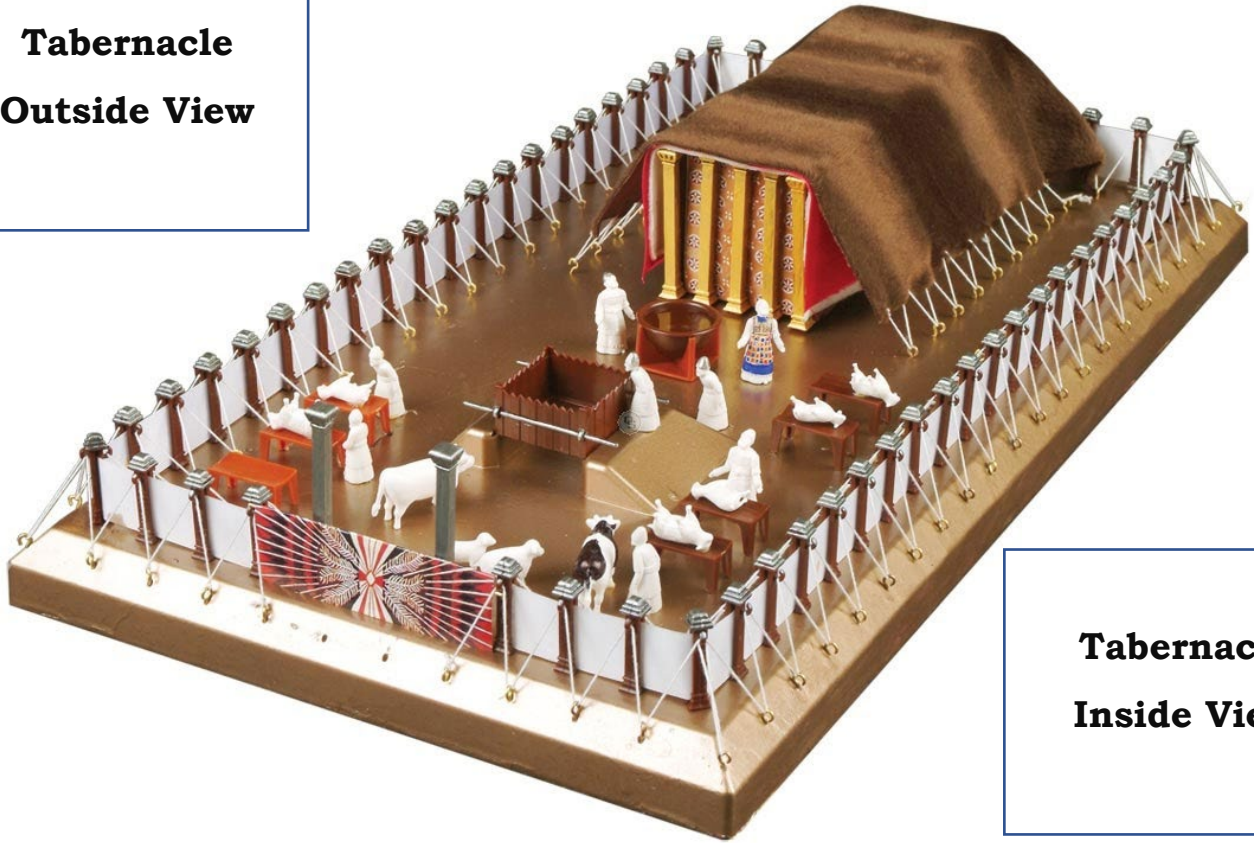

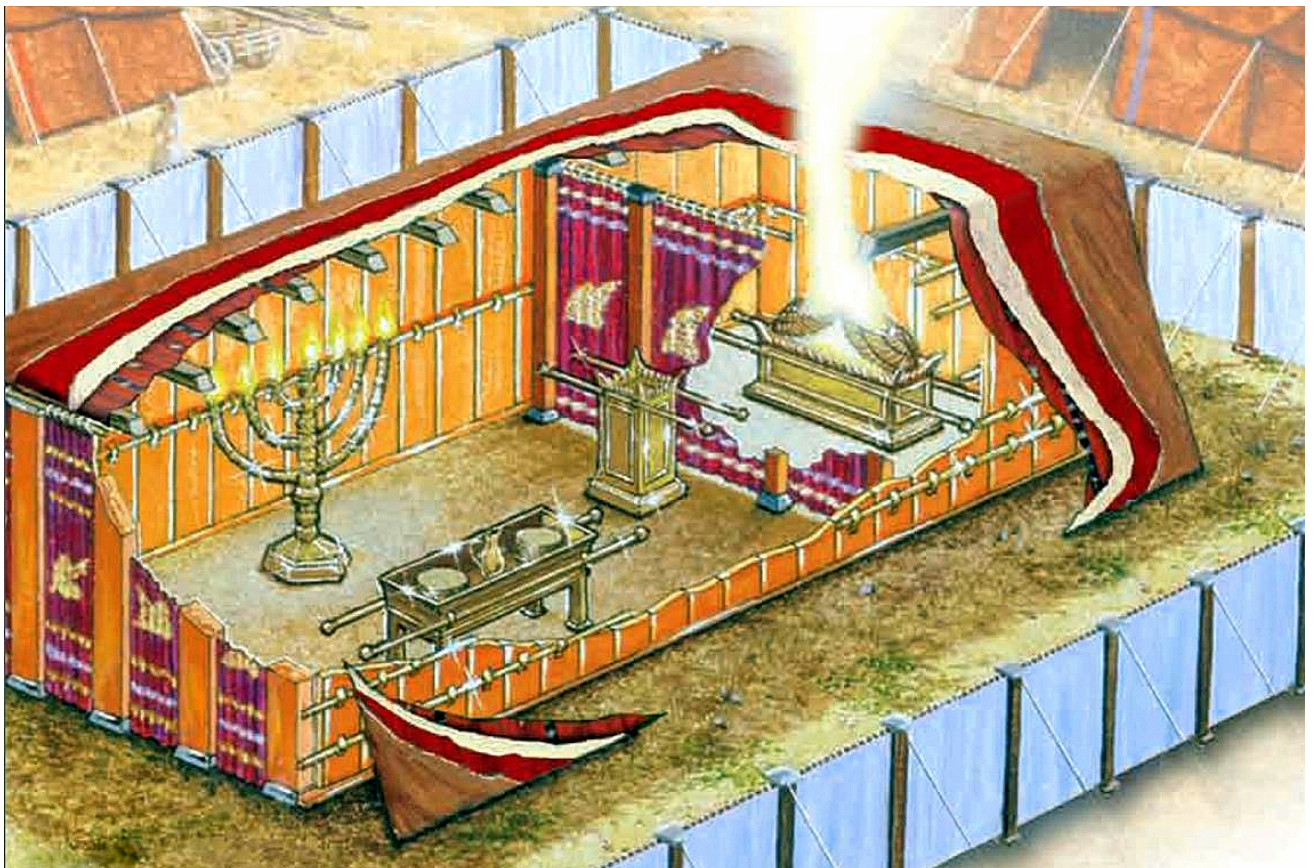

Outside View**



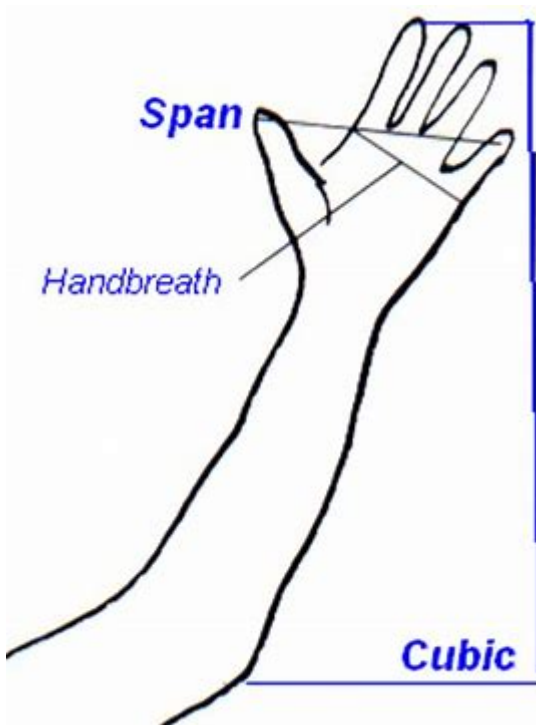
**Tabernacle

**Origin of
Measurement
“Cubit”**

Cubit: The common computation as to the length of the cubit makes it 20.24 inches for the ordinary cubit, and 21.888 inches for the sacred one.



Span: the distance from the end of the thumb to the end of the little finger of a spread hand also : an English unit of length equal to nine inches
