**Contents:** The tabernacle work begins. The curtains, coverings, sockets, bars, veil.

**Characters:** **GOD**, Moses, Bezaleel, Aholiab.

**Conclusion:** The talents with which **GOD** has entrusted the believer are not to be laid up but laid out. Have your tools ready and **GOD** will find you work. **See Proverbs 18:16.**

**Key Word:** Work, 1.

**Strong Verses:** 1, 5, 6.

**Striking Facts:** Precious souls redeemed by **CHRIST** are the material of the Gospel tabernacle. (1 Peter 2:5). Those called to the building of this house are those whom **GOD** has in some measure made fit for the work. Ability and willingness are the two things to be regarded in the call of the Christian worker.
