Contents: The Tabernacle is set up. **GOD's** glory is manifested.

Characters: **GOD**, Moses, Aaron.

Conclusion: **GOD** will dwell with those who prepare **HIM** a habitation (a place to be/live). Wherever **GOD** has a throne and an altar in the heart, there is a living temple in which the **SPIRIT** will be manifested (shown).

Key Word: Finished, 33.

Strong Verses: 17, 34, 38.

Striking Facts: Before...there was the tabernacle and the glory cloud. Now, there is the **Living Church** (the believer's body) and the **HOLY SPIRIT** (1 Corinthians 6:19).
