Contents: Israel at Sinai and the preparation for receiving The Law.

Characters: **GOD**, Moses, Aaron.

Conclusion: Humble reverence should possess the minds of those who draw near to **GOD** for we are sinners in the presence of a holy and righteous **JUDGE**, the **MIGHTY CREATOR**.

Key Word: Ready, 11, 15.

Strong Verses: 5, 6.

Striking Facts: (Cp. 1 Peter 2:9; Revelation 1:6, 5:10 with Exodus 15:5). Note that what *under law*, was conditional, *under Grace* is freely given in Christ to every believer. Note also that **GOD** did not impose law until it was proposed and accepted by man.

Questions:

1. How many days had it been since Israel had left Egypt?
2. What did they have to do ***before*** meeting **GOD**?
3. What announced **GOD**'s presence?
4. What could they not do when **GOD** came down?
5. Who was with Moses?
6. What did **GOD** call Israel?
7. Why did **GOD** want to speak to Moses in the presence of the people?

Discussion Question: why did GOD threaten death if they touched the mountain?
