Conclusion: Ministers of **JESUS CHRIST** are reprovers [**reprimand or censure (someone)**] by office, because they are to 1.) Preach the Word, 2.) Correct those who are inconsistent in its application. Great care should be taken however, by considering the age and circumstances of the persons rebuked. Ministers of **GOD** are accountable to **GOD** and the Lord **JESUS CHRIST** and are to observe the duties of their office. Ministers of **GOD** will be judged by their work as ministers for **GOD**.
