Contents: Meat offering and first-fruits laws.

Characters: GOD, Moses, Aaron's sons.

Conclusion: Leaven, respresenting sin, wickedness and human pride is not accepted in spiritual sacrifices. Take heed of those sins which will certainly spoil the acceptableness of worship.

Key Word: Fine flour offering, 1. First-fruits, 12.

Strong Verses: 11.

Striking Facts: Fine flour speaks of the balance of the character of Christ; fire of **HIS** testing by suffering; frankincense of the fragrance of **HIS** life to **GOD**; absence of leaven, **HIS** character as "The Truth;" <u>absence of honey</u>—**HIS** life was not mere natural sweetness which may exist apart from **GOD**; <u>oil mingled</u>, Christ as born of the Spirit; <u>oil upon</u>, Christ baptized with the Spirit.
