Contents: Peace offering laws.

Characters: **GOD**, Moses, Aaron's sons.

Conclusion: In **CHRIST, GOD** and the sinner meet in peace. **GOD** is propitiated and the sinner reconciled; both alike are satisfied with **CHRIST**'s work. "He is our peace."

Key Word: Peace offering, 1.

Strong Verses: 2.

Word Study:

Propitiate - *[Noun]* win or regain the favor of (a **GOD**, spirit, or person) by doing something that pleases them.

Propitiation - *[Noun]* That by which **GOD** is rendered propitious, i.e., by which it becomes consistent with **HIS** character and government to pardon and bless the sinner. The **propitiation** does not procure **HIS** love or make **HIM** loving; it only renders it consistent for **HIM** to exercise **HIS** love towards sinners.

Procure - *[Verb]* obtain (something), especially with care or effort

Offal – *[Noun]* the entrails and internal organs of an animal used as food.

Striking Facts: Details of the peace offering bring out the thought of fellowship, hence the peace offering is set forth as affording food for the priests, (Leviticus 7:31-34).
