Leviticus Chapter 7 Student

Contents: Additional instructions regarding the who and the what of sacrifices.

Characters: GOD, Moses, Aaron and sons.

Conclusion: We are required to follow specific actions regarding **GOD's** directives in everything. All sacrifices point to the coming MESSIAH that will *permanently* take away all sins.

Key Word: Offerings, 1.

Strong Verses: 37,38.

Striking Facts: The use of leaven (spiritual impurity), verse 13, is significant. In verse 12, as the believer thanks **GOD** for his peace, he first of all presents Christ (a sacrifice without leaven (sin), Ephesians 2:13. In verse 13, he gives thanks for his participation in the peace, and the leaven signifies, that although having peace through Christ, the believer in himself is not perfect.

- 9. What part of the animal shall be heaved and then given to Aaron's sons?
