Contents: Consecration of Aaron and sons for the priesthood.

Characters: GOD, Moses, Aaron and sons.

**Conclusion:** All who minister in holy matters must be as precise as possible with regard to **GOD**'s commands. Total observance of these commands will cause **GOD** to be please with their service.

**Key Word:** Sanctification, 12.

Strong Verses: 13, 36.

**Striking Facts:** Priests did not <u>consecrate</u> themselves. Moses was the appointed instrument of **GOD** to do this work. The sons of Aaron simply presented themselves for the work. See Romans 12:1, where the believer presents himself unreservedly to Christ.
