Contents: Consecration of Aaron and sons for the priesthood.

Characters: **GOD**, Moses, Aaron and sons.

Conclusion: All who minister in holy matters must be as precise as possible with regard to **GOD's** commands. Total observance of these commands will cause **GOD** to be please with their service.

Key Word: Sanctification, 12.

Strong Verses: 13, 36.

Striking Facts: Priests did not consecrateⁱ themselves. Moses was the appointed instrument of **GOD** to do this work. The sons of Aaron simply presented themselves for the work. See Romans 12:1, where the believer presents himself unreservedly to Christ.
