Student

Contents: Priests begin their ministry before the Lord.

Characters: **GOD**, Moses, Aaron and sons.

Conclusion: **GOD** draws nigh(near) to those who draw nigh(near) to **HIM** in the appointed way— with the offering of faith in **HIS SON** the Great Sacrifice being acceptable to **HIM**.

Key Word: Offering presented, 12.

Strong Verses: 6, 23, 24.

Striking Facts: **GOD** does not consecrateⁱ and ordainⁱⁱ priests to be idle. Without a days respite after their consecration, Aaron and **HIS** sons were immediately employed. **GOD**'s spiritual priests have work laid out for them by **CHRIST**.

1. What did Aaron's sons do with the blood from the sacrifices?

2. What were the items which were sacrificed?

3. What did Moses promise Aaron?

4. Did the glory of the LORD appear?

5. What happened to the sacrifices?

Discussion Question: What would you have done if you saw fire from GOD?

ⁱ **Consecrate** - (properly some form of the verb $\kappa\alpha\delta\alpha\sigma\eta\iota$, kadash', to be holy, often rendered "sanctify;" $\epsilon\gamma\kappa\alpha\iota\nu\iota\zeta\omega$, to dedicate; $\tau\epsilon\lambda\epsilon\iota\omega$, to complete), the act of devoting or setting apart anything to the worship or service of God

ⁱⁱ **Ordain** - in a common, but limited and technical sense, [it] is the **ceremony** by which an individual is set apart to an order or office of the Christian ministry.
