Leviticus Chapter 9 Student

Contents: Priests begin their ministry before the Lord.

Characters: GOD, Moses, Aaron and sons.

Conclusion: GOD draws nigh(near) to those who draw nigh(near) to **HIM** in the appointed way— with the offering of faith in **HIS SON** the Great Sacrifice being acceptable to **HIM**.

Key Word: Offering presented, 12.

Strong Verses: 6, 23, 24.

Striking Facts: *GOD* does not consecrate and ordain priests to be idle. Without a days respite after their consecration, Aaron and *HIS* sons were immediately employed. *GOD*'s spiritual priests have work laid out for them by *CHRIST*.

i Consecrate - (properly some form of the verb ψτζ, kadash', to be holy, often rendered "sanctify;" ἐγκαινίζω, to dedicate; τελείοω, to complete), the act of devoting or setting apart anything to the worship or service of God

Ordain - in a common, but limited and technical sense, [it] is the **ceremony** by which an individual is set apart to an order or office of the Christian ministry.
