Contents: Continuation of "The Sermon on the Mount". Ritual Formalism condemned. The new revelation of prayer (disciples prayer). The law of riches. Cure of anxiety.

Characters: GOD, JESUS.

Conclusion: True relationship with **GOD** will be manifested by:

- 1.) Demonstrating agape to all mankind men,
- 2.) Speaking/Living by absolute sincerity,
- **3.)** Humility in one's prayer life,
- **4.)** Laying up heavenly treasures and,
- **5.)** By absolute confidence in the Heavenly Father to supply all real needs and overcoming all troubling circumstances.

Key Word: Prayer, 5.

Strong Verses: 1, 6, 8, 9-13, 19, 20, 21, 33, 34.

Striking Facts: 8-13. Rather than the "Lord's prayer," this should be designated as "the Disciple's Prayer," because *JESUS* does not have the needs expressed in this prayer.

This prayer model provides a structure for A Believer's authentic true prayer, because:

- 1.) Puts the Father's interest before personal interests,
- 2.) Puts earthly needs in right proportion to spiritual needs,
- 3.) Bases prayer upon relationship, and
- 4.) The believer trusts **GOD** for present needs, and not worrying about the morrow.
