### Student

**Contents:** Times of the Gentiles to end in a period of forty-two months. Two heavenly witnesses will prophecy on the earth. The seventh trumpet judgment.

**Characters:** **GOD**, **HOLY SPIRIT**, **CHRIST**, John, two witnesses, beast, elders.

**Conclusion:** The Tribulation days which close the times of the Gentiles shall culminate in a period of intense troubles lasting 42 months (3½ years). When these days come, **GOD** will send two messengers to earth to warn the Gentiles. They will be poorly treated and killed as was our **JESUS** and the prophets before **HIM**. Woe to those who shall see these days, but happy those who through **JESUS CHRIST** are safe with **HIM** and engaged eternally in **HIS** praises.

**Striking Facts:** 3, 15. As the days of **CHRIST**'s reign approach there will be increased announcement of the apocalyptic truths which will be scoffed [**mocked**] at by the majority. (2 Peter 3:3-4) The final announcement will be made in the midst of the great Tribulation by heaven-prepared witnesses, as **HIS** first advent was announced by John the Baptist. With this testimony rejected and the witnesses killed, men will be abandoned to the terrible days of the last half of the Tribulation, after which **CHRIST** will come to reign forever.
