Striking Facts: THE LION and the **LAMB** are **ONE** (5). The sacrifice of the **LAMB** made **HIM** the **SAVIOUR** of the redeemed, but **HE** has not yet assumed power as the Lion, for the execution of judgment when **HIS** purpose in the Church is perfected. Notice in verse 9 that it is the blood that the saints are still singing about.
