#### Titus Chapter 3 Student

**Contents:** Further instructions concerning pastoral work of a true minister.

**Characters: GOD**, **CHRIST**, **HOLY SPIRIT**, Paul, Titus, Artemas, Tychicus, Zenas, Apollos.

**Conclusion:** The ministers of **CHRIST** should remind believers of their duty as children of **GOD**. They should urge believers of their duty to obey **GOD**ly government, which does not conflict with Scripture. This will remind non-believers of the truth of the undeserved favor of **GOD** in **CHRIST**, and the necessity of doing good works for **HIS** glory.

Strong Verses: 5, 8.

**Striking Facts:** 5, 8. <u>We cannot serve to get saved</u><sup>*i*</sup>. Our salvation is based alone on **CHRIST** 's finished work which cancels guilt, and the regenerating work of the **HOLY SPIRIT** which washes the fallen nature. (5) While we are not saved by service, we are "<u>saved to serve</u>" (8, 14) which is the manifestation of the salvation wrought<sup>ii</sup> in us by the Spirit.

### Justification –

## G1344 δικαιοω dikaioo dik-ah-yo'-o

From <u>G1342</u>; to render (that is, show or regard as) just or innocent: - free, justify (-ier), be righteous.

# G1342 δίκαιος dikaios dik'-ah-yos

From G1349; *equitable* (in character or act); by implication *innocent*, *holy* (absolutely or relatively): - just, meet, right (-eous).

# G1349 δίκη dike dee'-kay

Probably from G1166; *right* (as self *evident*), that is, *justice* (the principle, a decision, or its execution): - judgment, punish,

# **G1166** δεικνύω deiknuo dike-noo'-o

A prolonged form of an obsolete primary of the same meaning; to *show* (literally or figuratively): - shew.

<sup>ii</sup> Wrought - archaic past and past participle of <u>work</u>.

**iii** Chide - scold or rebuke.
