Contents: Defilement of the camp.

Characters: God, Moses.

Conclusion: The purity of the church (body) must be as carefully guarded with regard to its order and edification. Care should be taken to prevent the encouragment those who are openly and incorrigibly contrary to moral and behavioral purity. Those who do not repent should be cut off from communion.... until they repent. **(See Matthew 18:15-20)**

Strong Verses: 3

Striking Facts: All wives (church members) should learn from the "jealousy offering" to guard against giving any occasion for suspicions of their chastity, and to abstain from all "appearance of evil". (See Romans 14:13-16). Husbands should learn <u>not</u> to entertain causeless or unjust suspicions of their wives.
