Conclusion: JESUS CHRIST as **GOD** was equal with the **FATHER**, but as **GOD**-man revealed the **FATHER** to men and became the Mediator between **GOD** and men. **JESUS** is appointed heir of all things, sovereign Lord, absolute disposer and director both of all persons and all things. **JESUS** is above every other messenger ever sent into the world and has a name preeminent above all heavenly beings.

Word Study:

CHRIST - G5547 khris-tos'

From G5548; anointed, that is, the Messiah, an epithet of Jesus

G5548 xρίω khree'-o through the idea of contact; to smear or rub with oil, that is, (by implication) to consecrate to an office or religious service

epithet - an adjective or descriptive phrase expressing a quality characteristic of the person or thing mentioned.

Striking Facts: 3. The person of the **SON** was the true image and character of the Person of the **FATHER**. **HE** is not said to be the "likeness" of **GOD** (implying resemblance) but "image," which means that **JESUS** reveals **GOD**. In beholding **JESUS**' power, wisdom and goodness, men were beholding the **FATHER**, because **JESUS** was **GOD** manifest in the flesh, having all the perfections of **GOD** in **JESUS**.
