Chapter 7 Student

Contents: Melchisedec as a type *CHRIST*. Comparison of Melchisedec (See Genesis 14:28) and Aaronic priesthoods.

Characters: GOD, CHRIST, Melchisedec, Abraham, Levi, Aaron, Moses.

Conclusion: JESUS CHRIST is the true King-Priest, and is greater than all the priests of the order of Aaron (since they are flawed humans), and is the **"TRUE"** mediator of all blessings for all of humankind. Whereas the Levitical priesthood could bring nothing to perfection (and had to be repeated annually), and did not erase the guilt of humankind. The priesthood **CHRIST** brings with it a better hope, which is:

- A. A foundation of eternal salvation,
- B. Perfect security in **HIM** as our heavenly Intercessor.

Word Study:

Clergy: the body of all people ordained for religious duties, especially in the Christian Church.

Strong Verses: 19, 24-27.

Striking Facts: 26. No priest could be suitable or sufficient for our permanent reconciliation to **GOD**, but **ONE** who could meet the conditions, "a sinless life" which only **JESUS** alone could meet. **HE** alone was:

- a. Free from all habits or principles of sin,
- b. Never did the least wrong to God or man,
- c. Was absolutely undefiled in His own life, and,
- d. Was never accessory to other man's sins.

Those who come to **GOD** by belief in the shed blood of **CHRIST** and **HIS** resurrection are saved, not only <u>FROM</u> the uttermost, but <u>TO</u> the uttermost. (25).
