Contents: The Laws (Ordinances) and Building (sanctuary) of the old covenant as archtypes of the new. The realities of the new covenant which is sealed by the blood of **CHRIST**.

Characters: **GOD, HOLY SPIRIT**, Aaron, High Priest, Moses.

Conclusion: **CHRIST** is a more excellent High Priest than any other High Priest, under the law, who was an example of the work **HE(JESUS)** came to do. **HE** has entered once for all people (past, present and future) within the Holiest place. Because **HE** is our High Priest the shedding of **HIS sinless** blood for us, made the perfect (complete) atoning sacrifice for us which makes the remission of our sins possible.

Wood Study:

Archetype - a very typical example of a certain person or thing; an original that has been imitated

Key Word: Atonement, 22.

Strong Verses: 11, 12, 15, 22, 24, 25-28.

Striking Facts: 24-28. We have here three great aspects of the work of **CHRIST**.

- a. Atonement—the past tense of His work for our salvation (**verse 26**),
- b. Advocacy—the present tense of His work for us (**verse 24**), and,
- c. Advent—when **HE** will return to complete our salvation from the very presence of sin. (**verse 28**)

2. What prevented the continual presence of the HOLY SPIRIT on the earth?

3. What was required to make the New Covenant possible?

Bonus Question: What is significant about the death of **CHRIST** which makes it different from the daily sacrifice of animals?
