Contents: Exhortations to the Believer . Separation and worship. Apostolic benediction.

Characters: God, Christ, Timothy.

Conclusion: Our **LORD JESUS** purchased us with **HIS** blood that **HE** might set us apart a peculiar people zealous of good works. We should therefore seek to excel in behaviors which would identify us as believers, having characteristics such as:

- a Brotherly love,
- b. Generosity,
- c. Contentment with our present circumstances,
- d. Obedience to those in spiritual authority over us,
- e. Steadfast faith,
- f. Patient in suffering, and
- g. Continual praise.

Strong Verses: 1, 5, 8, 9, 14-16.

Striking Facts: 12, 13. **JESUS** was the exact opposite of the sin offering, being offered "without the gate," a striking illustration of **HIS** humiliation as a sin bearer. The believer is therefore exhorted to go forth from the ceremonial law, from sin, from the world, and identify himself with **CHRIST**, being willing to bear **HIS** reproach in gratitude for the salvation He has provided.
